

Flight Lieutenant **Alan Lindsell**, who had originally been posted as a Flying Officer but had since been promoted and was therefore attached as supernumerary. He had served with Paul Richey for a short time in No. 1 Squadron in France, and had broken his back. Flight Lieutenant Lindsell was killed in action with No.181 Squadron on 27th September 1942. On arrival at 609, he immediately astonished the Intelligence Officer, Frank 'Ziggy' Ziegler, by demanding to be tested in aircraft recognition, which he described as "A hobby of mine".
