

OVERTON, Charles Nevil, joined 609 Squadron as a Pilot Officer in 1940, having served in 17 Squadron during 1939. He shot down a Bf110 on 12th August and next day got two Ju87's. He was injured and was off operations for some time. In 1942 he joined 145 Squadron as a flight commander, and on 3rd June damaged a Bf109. Six days later he destroyed one of these, and the following month became Commanding Officer. He received a DFC in October, by which time his score was 5. He did not claim any further victories.

Charles Neville 'Teeny' Overton. Joined in November 1939 whilst 609 were at Drem. Postwar, bought RAF Wellingore airfield and farmed Wellingore Heath.
