

WALLACE, Thomas Young, from Johannesburg, South Africa, joined the RAF, and in June 1940 was posted to 610 Squadron as a Sergeant. He was then posted to 111 Squadron, and on 15th August destroyed a Bf110 and shared a second. He claimed a Bf109 and damaged a Do17 on the 16th, and on the 18th destroyed a Do17 and damaged two more. On the 24th he damaged a Bf109, shared a Do17 on the 26th, and on the 31st shot down a Bf110 and damaged a second. On 4th September he claimed a Bf109, and damaged three others, and later received a DFM for 7 and shares, with 4 more probably destroyed. His final total was 8, but he was later killed in action.
